Dear Friends in Christ,

As I write this letter my thoughts are of my childhood friend, Kim, who celebrates a BIG birthday today. Kim and I have been friends 59 years as our mothers introduced us at the tender age of 12 months and although I have no memories of our first years as friends, I deeply treasure the gift of Kim's life. Our days and years were spent playing a variety of things, our imaginations as wild and free as the wind that blew across our Rapid City neighborhood. We played with our dolls, our paper dolls, Fisher Price little people and colored too many pictures to count. We imagined we were Laura Ingalls Wilder living on the open prairie or Hansel and Gretel being chased by the witch; who was always Kim's older sister.

Yet the bulk of my memories and thankfulness gravitates toward the times spent with Kim at her church. I can still feel the excitement pulsing through my heart as we sat on little red chairs in the church basement singing "Deep and Wide." "Deep and wide; deep and wide; there's a found flowing deep and wide." Although I could not articulate the theological meaning behind the song, my young heart was introduced to the good news that the love of Jesus is far deeper and wider than I could ever imagine. The fun continued as we would go right into our next song, "I've

Got the Joy, Joy, Joy, Joy Down in my Heart!" Needless to say, we were all out of breath after singing these songs and we would laugh and laugh.

Unbeknownst to her, Kim's invitation to church, Sunday school, vacation bible school and church camp introduced me to Jesus Christ. The Jesus who loved me. The Jesus who died for my sins and the Jesus who rose from the dead promising me eternal life. The astounding part is Kim never spoke those exact words to me, but her invitation set me on a journey I still travel today. A journey that has defined my life.

At the end of the month we will celebrate Christ the King Sunday. It is the last day of the church year as the church does not follow the normal lunar calendar. We end every church year with this Sunday. It's our last chance to try to figure out who this Jesus is, and was, before we begin looking for him to come again to us as a child in a manger. Next month we will sing the hymn "What Child is This?" and proclaim in the refrain three times, "This, this is Christ the King, whom shepherds guard and angels sing." But what kind of King is Jesus?

Christ our King lived not by brute force like the earthly rulers of his time, but by caring for others who needed him. Christ's power is not one of might, but one of love. Who introduced you to this Jesus? This King of Glory? Who needs you to introduce Jesus to them? Witnessing happens in a variety of ways, at any age, during any season of life. Thanks be to God! Happy Birthday Kim.
